Phase II of our vision is the construction of a new gathering place for hosting cultural events, community activities, and meetings.




WHY IS A CLINIC NEEDED?

Despite the adversity we face in our current clinic, we have an excellent track record providing primary care and behavioral health services. A new facility will allow us to provide trauma stabilization care for accidents that occur on the Glenn Highway and for commuters needing easy-access primary care or dental care.

WHO DO WE SERVE?

Our clinic will serve the nearly 20 mile gap between medical facilities in Eagle River and the Matanuska Valley. We also have written support from local health care providers that will refer business to us for patients that are uninsured or underinsured. We are well positioned to have a meaningful impact on the health and wellness of many.
